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Rules

Time Limits – Each speaker will have **2–3 minutes** to share their testimonies, comments or ask questions so everyone gets a turn.

Stay on Topic – Comments must focus on short-term rental regulations and related community issues. Tax questions and discussion can be discussed at a future opportunity with the appropriate leaders. This is not the proper time and will only produce confusion.

Repetition – If your point has already been made, please yield time so new perspectives can be heard.
